Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 8 May, making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust is able to provide the information below in response:

Request:

Please can you tell me how many patients with learning disabilities are inpatients at your trust?

Please can you tell me how many of these inpatients have a date for a planned transfer into the community?

Please can you tell me how many of these inpatients have been assessed by clinicians in the past 12 months to ascertain their suitability for transferring into the community?

Please can you tell me how long these inpatients have been at the trust?

Response:

Oxford Health NHSFT are a provider of specialist psychiatric services and community health services. The Trust does not yet provide inpatient learning disability services. There are currently no learning disability inpatients. The Trust does at times have inpatients admitted with Asperger's syndrome, and patients on the autistic spectrum disorder, and from time to time patients with a secondary diagnosis of learning disability.

If the Trust can provide broader information of a more historical nature please do let me know and we will process such a request for you.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to me and I will ensure the decision is reviewed. The Trust will consider undertaking a review if requested to do so within 40 working days of the date the response is received by the applicant, and will apply discretion if a longer period of time has passed.

Should you wish to make a complaint as a result of the outcome of such a review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision.

Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the Trust for FoI Act matters.
