Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 17 October, making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust is able to provide the information below in response:

Request:

How many current Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust (Oxford Health) employees are from East Timor? Many such persons may have Portuguese citizenship, so those from East Timor can be defined as anyone who is known to the university to have East Timorese citizenship, has previously lived in East Timor (this information may have been collected by occupational health) or speaks Tetum or Fataluku as a first/primary language. If there is any other way that Oxford Health defines nationality that would include information regarding those from East Timor but with Portuguese citizenship/right to work status, this would also be a relevant definition for my question.

Of the current Oxford Health employees from East Timor, how many employees are male and how many are female?

Of the current (Oxford Health) employees from East Timor who are male, and separately who are female, how many are employed at each agenda for change band (1-9) and each medical and dental staff pay bands if applicable?

Response:

Zero (0). There are no current East Timor employees.
