## **Language Activity Pack for word finding**

#### **Ideas for Word Finding Activities**

#### 1) Describe a word

Commercial games, such as Articulate or Taboo, can be bought. Alternatively, on small pieces of paper write down names of famous people, objects, things, verbs. Each person should try thinking of around twenty words. Fold up each piece of paper and put them in a bowl/container. Takes turns pulling out a piece of paper and describing it to your partner, but don't say the actual word.

#### 2) Categories

Think of a "<u>category</u>" and list as many items as you can that belong to that category. Start off with concrete categories such as animals, vegetables, furniture etc. and progress to abstract categories – such as things which are hot or cold, things that grow, things that are shiny etc.

#### 3) Semantic links

Take an object, person, place etc. and think of as many words as you can which relate to it, e.g.: dog – barks, lead, wag, collar, panting, hairy, etc.

#### 4) Synonyms / antonyms

Think of a word, or choose one from the dictionary / thesaurus and see if you can think of another word which means the <u>same</u> or has a similar meaning. Alternatively, try to think of a word that means the <u>opposite</u> to the word you've selected.

#### 5) Defining words

Select words e.g. from a dictionary, and try to explain their meaning.

#### 6) Word games

Complete crosswords, arrow words etc. found in magazines or puzzle books.
