Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 18th December making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust is able to provide the information below in response:

Request:

I work for the Disabilities Trust and we are in the initial stages of setting up a new project for those with a comorbid diagnosis of autism spectrum conditions and mental health conditions and I am looking for some statistics to help generate funding.

I have searched for the information myself but have not been able to find any as yet.

Please could you provide the number of Buckinghamshire patients (total across whole trust, or even split within different localities) both inpatient and community based, that have a dual diagnosis of a mental health condition and autism spectrum condition?

This is for adult please.

Please can you look against F80-F89 – Disorders of psychological development for the following codes:

F20-F29 – Schizophrenia, Schizotypal and delusional disorders

F30-F39 – Mood (affective) disorders

F40 – F48 – Neurotic, Stress related and somatoform disorders

F60 – F69 – Disorder of adult personality and behaviour.

Response:

Running a report for current community and in-patients, with Buckinghamshire County Council as the Local Authority and aged over 18 at their last birthday there are 22 patients who meet the criteria of an ICD10 code specified in the request.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to me and I will ensure the decision is reviewed. The Trust will consider undertaking a review if requested to do so within 40 working days of the date the response is received by the applicant, and will apply discretion if a longer period of time has passed.

Should you wish to make a complaint as a result of the outcome of such a review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision.

Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the Trust for FoI Act matters.
